Overview of river cleanup and what to expect

The Tittabawassee River cleanup project starts along the Dow Chemical Property in Midland and runs about 21 miles to the Saginaw River in Saginaw. Map at left. There is a larger version of the map on page 3.

To make the project manageable the river is divided into seven segments. [Page 3 has a map showing recognizable landmarks.](#)

Work is being done both in the river and in the floodplain. Page 4 has a detail map of Segment 6 & 7. Work is expected to take place in 2020.

There is also a potential cleanup work on the Middlegrounds island in the Saginaw River in Bay County during 2020. See page 4 for location of the island.

Projected time line

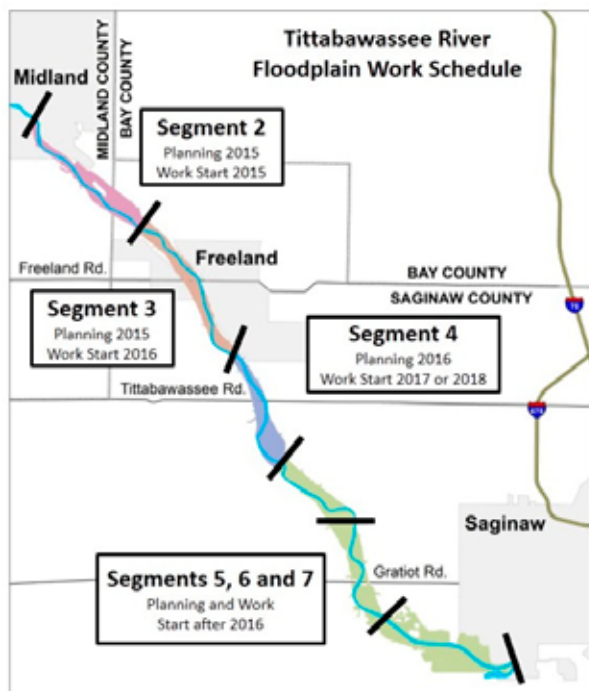
2020

- Work in segment 6 & 7
- Potential cleanup on the Middlegrounds Island

2021

- Work progressing into the upper Saginaw River

EPA's plan is to conduct cleanups from upstream to downstream, segment-by-segment, with river, bank and floodplain work being done concurrently as much as possible.



Map at left shows potential times work will start in the floodplain in various segments.

It is difficult to define exact segment boundaries because they don't often start or stop at common landmarks like a road or drain.
