Advisory Signs/Communication

Goal of Updates to Communication Materials:

- Mitigate risk from the site contaminations (direct exposure from soil, fish contamination, etc)
- Accurate and Current information about exposures to risks from the Site.
- Evaluate and update/improve how information is making it out into the community.
- Collaborative multi-Agency effort (EGLE/DHHS/EPA/MDNR/MDARD) along with CAG to develop format and mode of method to communicate message.
- Action Item: CAG Subcommittee.
- Assist in the development of the methods to communicate about the exposure routes but also update/progress message.
 - Multi-pronged approach featuring multiple methods of communicating to a variety of audiences.
