Saginaw CAG to hold meetings in Freeland

As the Tittabawassee River cleanup moves into Saginaw County and more populated areas of the river, the Saginaw-Tittabawassee Rivers Contamination Community Advisory Group (CAG) will move it's bi-monthly meeting to Freeland Memorial Park, 150 Park St., Freeland, MI. This will make the meetings, which are open to the public, more assessable for residents and other interested parties. The next CAG meeting is Tuesday, March 17, 2015 at 6:00 PM.

The CAG is composed of a broad cross-section of representatives from Bay, Midland and Saginaw counties. It serves as the focal point for exchange of information between residents, the Environmental Protection Agency, Dow Chemical, state regulatory agencies, and other federal agencies involved in cleanup of the Tittabawassee and Saginaw Rivers.

Residents who live along the Tittabawassee and Saginaw Rivers, and those who enjoy the local rivers, are invited to attend and learn more about the cleanup and offer input and questions for the CAG to pass along to the EPA and Dow Chemical.

The CAG is seeking individuals from the community to serve on the committee. Current activities include looking at cleanup plans for the river and floodplains.
